The youth of All Saints parish have always been involved in worship in one way or another. Some are acolytes, serving the altar and carrying the procession cross, some act as ushers, some are lectors and even Eucharistic ministers. On a designated Youth Sunday the Youth Group conducts worship by leading all of the service, including preaching the homily, with the exception of presiding at the Eucharist.

Youth Group, for Junior and Senior High School youth, meets as arranged by the group, most often on alternate Sunday afternoons. They often meet together with the youth from another church for social and service activities. Youth Group, with adult volunteer assistance, provide Pancake Breakfasts throughout the year, principally on Mothers' Day and Fathers' Day, when the parent featured eats free!

Youth Sunday Mornings is the class for Junior and Senior High young people. It meets between services at 9:30 a.m. for discussion of issues touching their lives and for learning about Holy Scripture and the Episcopal Church. Often some of the time is used for planning events. Everyone is welcome.
