Rector's Report

Heather Hill, Rector



Bell Tower update: The company that worked on our tower in the past inspected the ledge where stone fell off, crashing in front of the red doors. They were able to remove additional loose stone with their hands! Insurance is covering the replacement of the stone that fell, minus our \$500 deductible. They crew thoroughly inspected the rest of the tower and have recommended repairs totaling around \$47,000, which would not be covered by insurance.

Furnace update: Over the past two winters Vestry has been considering the replacement of two of the furnaces that heat the sanctuary. Our oldest furnace is over thirty years old and has a cracked heat exchanger. The furnaces limped through the winter, but we do not know how much longer they will last. Over the course of the winter we spent over \$2,000 repairing the two furnaces that heat the Parish Hall. Now they need another \$700 part that we replaced only two years ago! We have been counseled to replace them rather than continue to throw away more money in continuous repairs.

All Saints Vestry and Pastor Heather have submitted a request for grant and loan money to the Diocese with the intention of using this money to repair the tower, replace the furnaces, and resurface our

parking lot. The money from the Planting for Tomorrow campaign will also be used to fund these necessary repairs. Unfortunately, it will not be enough to cover all of them. If you are able to help us with additional funds, please put it in an envelope marked Major Improvements or speak with Pastor Heather, our Treasurer, Marcia Day, or our Senior Warden, Jeff Fowler.
