### Pledge In-Gathering

Sunday, November 13th is Pledge In-Gathering Sunday. Please bring your pledge cards to the service where we will pray over them and present them to God.

### All Saints Day Remembrances

Our worship committee has decided to try something different with remembering the saints this year. We are inviting you to write the name of those you would like to remember on a white origami crane. Origami cranes are a symbol of hope of what is to come. In our case we look forward to the time when we will be united with our loved ones. These cranes will be hung around the sanctuary for All Saints Day celebrations and the Sundays before Advent.

### Taizé Service

Sunday, November 13 at 6:00 PM we come together for prayer in a way begun over 70 years ago in the ecumenical community of Taizé in southern France. Our purpose is to quiet our minds and hearts and to focus on worshiping the living God, that our faith may be deepened by the power of prayer.

The quieting of the mind and heart does not happen immediately, but gradually, as we become more comfortable in the silence, as we hear and sing the repeated words of the songs, as we listen to readings from Holy Scripture, and as we give ourselves over to God's peace.

#### Greater Cleveland Food Bank Partnership

We are investigating whether the Greater Cleveland Food Bank is a good option for supplying hot meals for our senior dinners. The food bank kitchen prepares meals seven days each week. If we proceed with this project we will have to host a monthly meal (a food bank requirement) and we will have to identify some volunteers who can be available to pick up the food at the food bank before each meal. The food bank is located at 15500 South Waterloo Road, just off I-90. In addition, some volunteers will have to be trained in proper food handling.

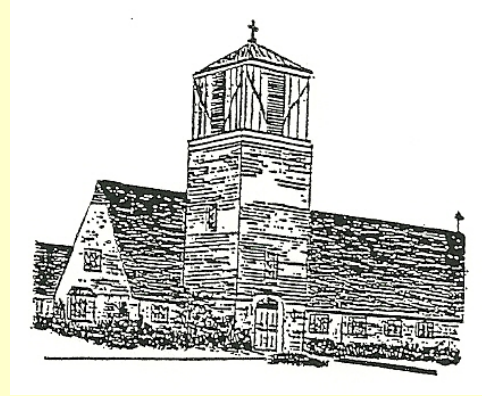
